

Policy on Transgender Athlete Participation

- 1. A trans male (FTM) student-athlete who is taking a hormone related treatment related to gender transition, may compete on a boys' team in a PrimeTime Sports event, but is no longer eligible to compete on a girls' team.
- 2. A trans female (MTF) student- who is taking a hormone related treatment related to gender transition, may compete on a girls' team in a PrimeTime Sports event, but is no longer eligible to compete on a boys' team.
- 3. For application of the above rules for transgender participation, the parent/guardian of the athlete must provide to PrimeTime Sports, in advance of the competition, a letter from a medical provider or other noninvasive documentation as to the athlete receiving hormone treatment related to gender transition.
- 4. Any transgender athlete who is not taking hormone treatment related to gender transition may participate in accordance with his or her assigned birth gender.
